Boddingtons Pub Ale 5.0% Belgium Classic English Pale Ale 16 oz. \$7.00

A very crisp looking, dark-brown cream-ale that has a one-finger head that lasts. Smell of extreme bitterness readies your palate for the upcoming brew. The frothy, whipped head, mixes into a pleasant blend of sweetness with a bit of bitter flavorings to clean up the palate.

Cricket Hill Paymasters Porter 5.0% USA Porter 16 oz. \$8.00

A dark brown Ale with major coffee flavors but not burnt aftertaste. The background is slightly chocolate with wonderful candied undertones. It finishes with a marvelous mixture of chocolate and coffee. A non-filtered ale that lives up to the gentle session beer reputation that our brewery has become well known for

Dark Horse Crooked Tree I.P.A. 6.0% USA American India Pale Ale 16 oz. \$8.00

Inspired by West Coast I.P.A.'s, but brewed with Michigan style. The Crooked Tree is heavily dry hopped to give it a big aroma of pine and citrus. The flavors are big, yet very balanced between fresh hops and malt. Often described as grapefruit our hops give this beer an excellent fruit flavor that finishes dry, crisp, and clean.

Dogfish Head Ta Henket 4.5% USA Old Ale 16 oz. \$8.00

Ta Henket is brewed with an ancient form of wheat and loaves of hearth-baked bread, and it's flavored with chamomile, doum-palm fruit and Middle Eastern herbs.

Elysian Mens Room Original Red 5.6% USA American Pale Ale 16 oz. \$8.00

A portion of the net proceeds from every Men's Room Original Red sold goes to helping support the families of our military vets through the VA Puget Sound Fisher House and Ft. Lewis Fisher House. The Mens Room Original Red is brewed for The Mens Room Radio Show on 99.9 KISW The Rock of Seattle.

Firestone Bravo 13.5% USA American Brown Ale 16 oz. \$8.00

It is a lean simple barley wine brewed to show case barrel flavors. This batch has massive bourbon barrel notes that morph as the beer warms in the glass.

Mission Shipwrecked Double I.P.A. 9.3% USA Imperial or Double India Pale Ale 16 oz. \$8.00

A amazingly balanced and hoppy beer, yet finishes as smooth as silk with no hint of high alcohol hotness usually associated with strong double IPA's. Super citrus and grapefruit aromas and flavors from the generous use of Cascade, Magnum, Centennial and CTZ hops.

Pilsner Urquell 4.0% Czech Republic Bohemian/Czech Pilsener 16 oz. \$8.00

This bottom-fermented beer produced since 1842 in Pilsen, Czech Republic was the first pilsen type beer in the world (its name literally means first pilsner). Clear gold color and good amount of carbonation, the flavor begins with a slightly sweet maltiness that is quickly consumed by a hoppy finish

Saint Arnold Fancy Lawnmower 4.9% USA German Kölsch 16 oz. \$8.00

A true German-style Kölsch. Originally brewed in Cologne, this beer is crisp & refreshing, yet has a sweet malty body that is balanced by a complex, citrus hop character. Multiple additions of German Hallertauer hops are used to achieve this delicate flavor.

Stoudt's Brrrrright Lager 4.7% USA Lager 16 oz. \$8.00

A crisp, medium-body with a light amber color. It is assertively hopped with Pacific Northwest Cascades for a firm bitterness and delightfully floral aroma.

Tommyknocker Oaked Butt Head Bock 8.1% USA German Doppelbock 16 oz. \$8.00

Oaked Butt Head combines our award winning Butt Head Bock with finely toasted oak. The vanilla and spice character of the oak melds with the malty caramel flavors of our dopplebock

Wandering Star Red Oktober

A collision between two radically differing beer styles. The malt bill is classic Doublebock with German Munich, Caramunich and Melanoidin malts mashed at high temperatures to encourage dextrin production, and further caramelized in the mashtun and kettle. Color and hopping though are pure US Imperial Red with crystal rye malt providing a rich red-amber color. The complex blend of hops - Millennium, Warrior, Chinook for bittering; Simcoe, Amarillo and Centennial for flavor and aroma - provides 56 IBUs on top of 6.8% ABV; finally we added 2 lbs of freshly picked homegrown Cascade to the hopback to provide a further burst of green hop flavor. This is like your old stereo with the bass and treble both turned up to 11 - definitely not a session beer!

Weyerbacher Last Chance IPA

Weyerbacher's new Last Chance IPA is a west coast-style full-flavored hop assault delightfully lacking in balance. A combination of Centennial, Cascade, Simcoe and Columbus hops are used to produce pungent aromas of grapefruit, pine and citrus.

Trippel is bottle conditioned. This means a bit of candi-sugar and yeast just prior to bottling. This imparts effervescence to the beer, a creamier carbonation, and extends the shelf life. The on-going fermentation will change the character of the beer as it ages, it becomes dryer with age.
